The selection of books is intended to nurture our children's curiosity further in addition to providing opportunities explore inclusion, diversity and equality. Pupils get the opportunity to reflect upon and discuss these issues and the relevance in their lives.

The chosen texts will be explored through a P4C session, with pupils being given the opportunity to lead their learning a decide on the discussion points and 'big questions' they would like to explore. All teaching staff are Level I P4C trained, giving pupils the opportunity to explore life's 'big ideas.' Our Parish Spirit Reading Spine explores issues of Equality, Diversity and Inclusion. These are further enhanced by books from No Outsiders, our online safety reading spine and other relevant supporting texts.
