Fabric	Fabric is cloth or other material produced by weaving together cotton, nylon, wool, silk, or other threads. Fabrics are used for making things like clothes, curtains, and sheets.	
Texture	The way that something feels when you touch it, for example how smooth or rough it is.	
Attach	Join or fasten something to an object.	8
Scrap	A small piece of something that is no longer needed for its original purpose.	
Mixed media	Artwork that uses more than one materials.	
Collage	A picture that has been made by sticking pieces of coloured paper, cloth and other scrap materials onto paper.	
Appliqué	A decoration made of one material attached by sewing or gluing to an- other material.	Ďţ,
Layers	A piece of a material that covers a surface or that is between two other things.	
Combine	Join two or more things to make them one.	÷
Weave	Make a material by crossing threads over and under each other using a frame or machine called a loom.


