Last summer, we applied for funding for a free residential trip through the Generation Green project. Generation Green offers young people in England the chance to spend the night under the stars and connect with nature in protected landscapes. This initiative aims to widen access and engagement with these beautiful areas, boost nature connectedness, and provide the wellbeing benefits associated with being outdoors.

I am delighted to inform you that our application has been successful, and we have been awarded a free residential trip for our Y5 class in Malham, scheduled for the 26th-28th February. Due to the number of children from Y5 attending, Malham has offered to extend the residential to include Y4 children to ensure that as many children as possible can take advantage of this offer. I understand that this is short notice, but I believe this is an opportunity too good to miss. This trip is an excellent opportunity for our children to work as a team, improve their wellbeing, and connect with nature. I hope you agree that this is a fantastic chance for our children to experience something truly special. The trip is fully funded, meaning there will be no cost to you. This includes accommodation, activities, all meals, and a £25 travel bursary per child.
