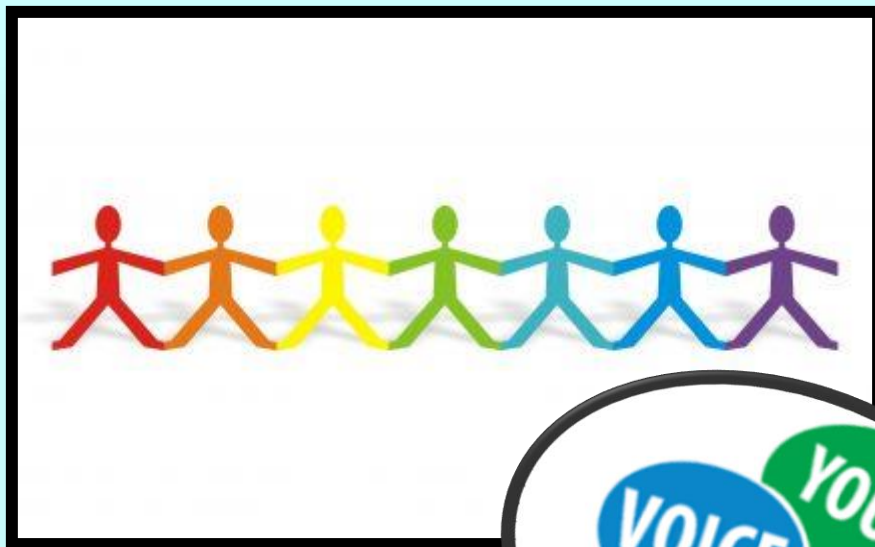


Journey Leaders Assemble!
