Log in	Using a username and password to access a system.
Log out	Leaving a computer system.
Username	A name that is used by a person to access an online site.
Password	A series of letters, numbers and special characters that is entered after the username to access an online site.
Avatar	A digital picture to represent someone.
Rules	A set list defining what is allowed.
Online	When a machine is turned on and connected to other devices.
Private Information	Information a user wishes to keep from public viewing.
Email	Short for electronic mail. Messages that may contain text, files, images, or other attachments sent through a network to a selected individual or group of individuals.
Notification	A system that lets you know if you have something to look at.

Passwords are like toothbrushes in that they should not be shared with anyone else.• An avatar is a picture you use to represent you. It is safer to use an avatar on the internet than have a picture of yourself.• When you save word the computer stores it as you create something so it can be accessed later.• Personal information tells other people who you are and where to find you. Things like your name, address, school and what you look like. You should not share this kind of information with people you don't know.• A username is a name that is used by a person to access an online site.• There are many different devices which can connect to the internet.
